BASKETBALL: Saturdays 9am – 10am at Lynmore Primary School gym, Iles Rd. Last day 16 Sept; restart 14 Oct



TEN PIN BOWLING: <u>Two sessions.</u> Saturdays at Strike Zone, Motion Entertainment, Te Ngae Rd. Last day 16 Sept; restart 14 Oct

The first session at 9.30am plays as an official league so teams are the same each week.
