TEN PIN BOWLING: Two sessions. Saturdays at Strike Zone, Motion Entertainment, Te Ngae Rd.

The first session plays as an official league (League A) so teams usually are the same each week whereas the second session "League B" teams may vary each week depending on who comes. The change happened last year because of Strike Zone's new computer system. New athletes are asked to attend the second session and Shona decides in consultation with the athlete which league to put the athlete in. Games are subsidised by Special Olympics Rotorua but we appreciate it if athletes can pay the rest.

League A - 9.30am play two games. By invitation only. **\$80 per term (\$8 for 2 games)**. Finishes by 10.30am
League B - 10.15am play one game. Includes new athletes. Usually finishes by 11.15am. **\$40 per term (\$4 per game)**. This is only half the full cost.
